Brief description of position:

A person on a team of three to seven mentors who are committed to a “friendship with a purpose” with someone struggling from the consequences of sin. I.e.: ex-prisoner, drug/alcohol addiction, homelessness, etc..

Benefits:

Personal growth in Jesus. The benefits are equivalent to ministering directly to the Lord. (See Matt. 25:31-46) Often the greatest blessing and growth is to the Mentors.

Major responsibilities/tasks :

- Ü Spend time with mentee in leisure time activities:
 - conversation - walks - trip to a park – fishing -
 - shopping – coffee – lunch – dinner - rodeo - ball games - etc.

- Ü Consider being in an “Eagle’s Nest” for your own growth.

Qualifications :

- Ü non-negotiable (must have)
 - interested in pursuing an intimate relationship with God.
 - gift of mercy & compassion.
 - a Servant’s heart.
 - good listener.
- Ü negotiable (would be nice to have)
 - similar leisure time interests as mentee.
 - free time.
